



Raymond W. Williams Hike and Bike Trail Pentagon Parkway

General Description

A relaxing trail for walking, biking, or rollerblading on the concrete sculpture walk that focuses on five strategically placed bronze works – the tallest being nine feet tall. The Five-Mile Creek Sculpture Walk is a public art project by the Office of Cultural Affairs. Five sculptures are located on either side of Five-Mile Creek, with one placed just above the bridge on the west side of Marsalis Avenue. The artist and the Five-Mile Creek Steering Committee, chaired by Raymond W. Williams, worked closely together on this project. The trail was renamed the Raymond W. Williams Hike and Bike Trail at Five-Mile Creek in 1998.

Directions to Trailhead from Downtown Dallas

Go south on I-35 for 5 miles to Ledbetter Drive (Loop 12); exit Ledbetter Drive; turn left; proceed 1.4 miles to Marsalis Avenue; turn left. Go to Pentagon Parkway; turn right. The trail is on the right.
