Blazing the Trails with Jeff

A highly successful year for our Dallas' trails system culminated with the first-ever meeting of the Dallas All Trails Group that brought together leaders from Dallas trail and bike friends groups. Leaders from BikeDFW, Circuit Trail Conservancy/The Loop, Northaven Trail, Preston Ridge Trail, Santa Fe Trail, Trinity Strand Trail, and White Rock Creek Trail met at Rodeo Goat along the Trinity Strand Trail to discuss opportunities for collaboration and trail improvements in 2022 and beyond. Joining us were Dallas Park and Recreation Board President Arun Agarwal and Rudy Karimi, Park and Recreation Board member for District 14.

Here's what we discussed during the meeting:

- Development of the Loop project and completion timeline
- Opportunities to resurface White Rock Creek Trail
- Northaven Trail's implementation of new red and white painted crosswalks to improve safety
- Efforts by BikeDFW to partner with trail groups with pop-up bike repair and education stations along trails
- Strategies to better connect our trail system throughout the City, including future bond elections and other sources of funding
